

Admission

- 1. The Management reserves the right to admit or to refuse admission to pupils seeking admission to the School. Similarly, the Management decides when the question of retaining a student in a Class arises.
- 2. Registration Forms will be available from the office. The allotment of the streams will be based on the pre-board exam results. The change of stream will not be allowed unless the candidate gets the demanded percentages in the ICSE exams.
- 3. At the time of admission, students and parents shall be required to sign an affidavit and declaration that on the admission he/she submits himself, herself to the disciplinary rules framed by the school.
- 4. All the admissions will be strictly on the basis of the result of Pre board exams. Any unfair means like attempt to bribe, recommendation etc will debar the candidate from getting admission.
- 5. After the admission, if the student fails to attend the Class, no refund of any kind shall be made.

Recommendation to the Parents

- 1. Parents are requested to bear in mind that the school attaches great importance to building a sound character in the pupils. Therefore the parents are expected to cooperate with the School by making their children understand that well ordered and a disciplined way of life is as important at home as in the School.
- 2. Parents are requested to co-operate with the school authorities in enforcing discipline.
- 3. Parents are expected to sign progress reports or any other similar documents when requested. Failure to do so will put their children to great inconvenience.
- 4. Parents are strictly forbidden to meet their wards or their teachers when classes are being held. Parents are requested to meet the teachers on the day of parent teachers meeting or with prior permission from the Principal.
- 5. If a student is likely to be ill for a long period the Principal must be informed as early as possible.
- 6. If absence, due to illness, lasts for more than three days, an application for leave must be made to the Principal, accompanied by a registered doctor's certificate.
- 7. Those who return to school after absenting themselves without leave shall not enter the class without the permission of the Principal.
- 8. When students are taken on tours/picnics or excursions, utmost care will be taken of their safety. How ever the authorities take up no responsibility for any outward incident which may take place on such occasions.
- 9. Parents are responsible for the arrangement of the conveyance of their ward to the School. Parents must see whether the Vehicle in which they are sending their ward is in proper condition and have fulfilled allthe requirements of the government.

- 2. Students must have a minimum of 80% attendance to be permitted to write the examinations.
- 3. Absentees at an examination will be considered as having failed unless it is established that their absence was due to illness.
- 4. Students who are absent from classes for 2 weeks or more at a stretch without the permission of the Principal obtained in writing, will be considered to have left the school.
- 5. When absence is caused by unforeseen events, application duly signed by parents for leave must be submitted to the Principal.

RULES OF DISCIPLINE

- 1. Every student must have the prescribed textbooks, laboratory records, dissecting instruments etc.
- 2. No student shall absent himself/herself from classes without the prior permission of the Principal.
- 3. The students are not allowed to bring motorized vehicles/ two wheelers to the school on working days Students are not permitted to bring mobile or any electronic gadgets in the School.
- 4. The students will be expelled in any condition of Physical assault or threat to use physical force against any member of the staff or against any students with in the School.
- 5. The students will be asked to discontinue from the school on the basis of unhealthy relationships with opposite sex.
- Smoking or use of any seductive by a student is strictly prohibited in the School and in the School premises. Those found violating this rule will be dismissed with immediate effect.
- 7. Bringing of arms and weapons like knives, chains, and fire arms to School and ganging up with the students of other schools justify immediate dismissal.
- 8. Any kind of damage done to School property must be paid by the parents/ guardian of the child. The decision of the principal regarding the amount to be paid is final.
- 9. Exchange of articles or money transactions between students are not allowed.
